Cowell Poetry Prize (\$100): For excellence in written poetry. Submit up to 3 poems, no longer than 6 pages total.

- Cowell Press Prize (\$100): For excellence in printing or book arts productions. Entries must be a single print project produced in the Cowell Press. Recipient need not be a Cowell Student.
- Cowell Illustration Prize (\$100): Awarded to the best illustration related to Cowell College life. These may be used on glasses, t-shirts, invitations, or on display in the Dizikes cases or library. No photos, original drawn art work only.
- The UCSC Annual Dante Prize (\$300): Awarded to the best essay dealing with any aspect of Dante's Divine Comedy. Recipient need not be a Cowell Student.
- John Dizikes Writing Prize (\$500): For excellent non-fiction prose writing in any field. Entries must consist of a single essay in English written for a UCSC course.
