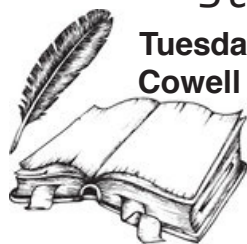

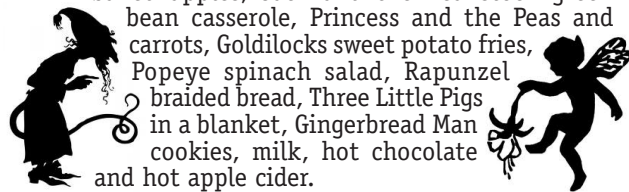
Once Upon a College Night: Storybook
