## **Apartment Cleaning Inspections**

Tuesday, Nov. 12 - Thursday, Nov. 14 Apartment Cleaning Inspections will be conducted between 11am - 5pm. Please clean the common areas including the kitchen, bathrooms, hallways, stairways and living and dining areas. We will not be inspecting individual rooms. Failed inspections lead to a follow up inspection and potentially a custodial order which you will be billed for. Further, your apartment will need to meet with your CRE to discuss the matter.

**Thanksgiving Break: November 28 - December 1**The Dining Halls will NOT be open during the Thanksgiving break. If staying on campus, plan ahead for food! No permission is necessary to stay over Thanksgiving break. The last Dining Hall meal served is lunch on Wednesday, Nov. 27; the first meal served is dinner on Sunday, Dec. 1.
