### In Memoriam ~ Robert Newman

Robert "Bob" Newman, father of Provost Faye Crosby and a much beloved member of the Cowell community, passed away on May 15, 2015 at 99 years of age. During his time at Cowell, Bob regularly attended Cowell College Nights - or at least, "only those that Faye attended" - and he was often the first person to greet visitors who walked through the door at the Provost's House. He will be remembered by students, faculty, and staff alike for his kind demeanor, welcoming spirit, and keen sense of humor.
