Introduction

Welcome Leaders (WLs) assist new Cowell frosh and transfer students during Fall Welcome Week. WLs are essential in providing a smooth Move-In for students. They work cooperatively with residential and college staff to help new students become familiar with Cowell, the campus, and its resources.

Being a WL is a great opportunity to help new students, develop leadership skills, be a part of a fun and close-knit team, and contribute to student life at Cowell. The WL position involves several endeavors: advance training this spring quarter (5-10 hours), Cowell Commencement this June (7 hours, for event experience), a full week of training before fall quarter (50-60 hours), and fall Move-In and Welcome Week (40-60 hours).
